It's not a biopic of any known person, but it's a biographical comedy-drama on any intelligent scam which triggered big economic collapse.

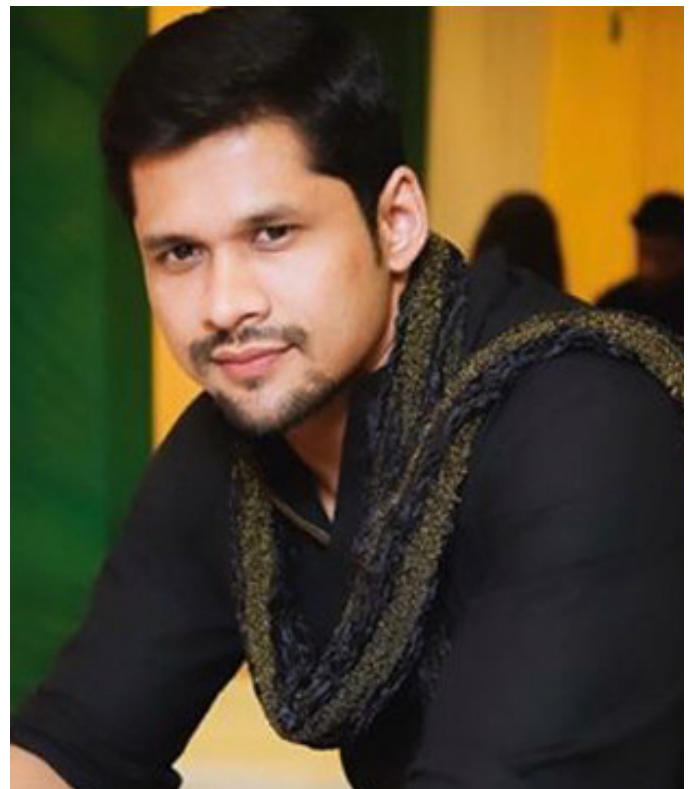
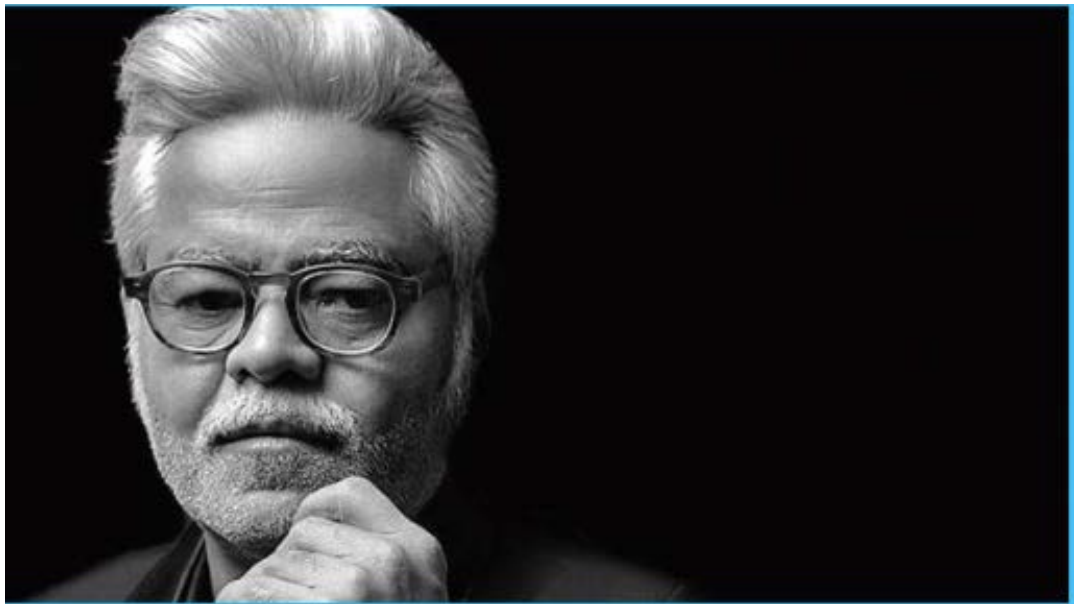
The Genre

Only three remain on his side. The office is buried in layers of files. The company is in a state as though it's fighting a war with the world. 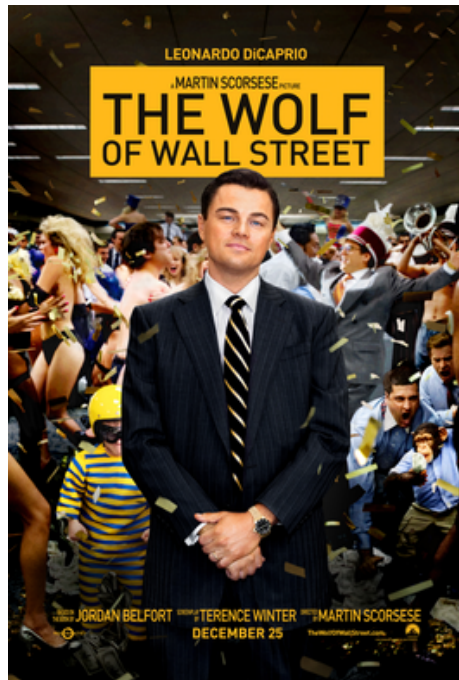
